The Helvetia 1291 Fund invests primarily in shares of Swiss companies, which are actively selected. Equities are selected using a multi-stage investment process based on a bottom-up approach. Companies with a convincing business model, low debt, solid financial ratios, and a good management track record are considered. The active selection of equities in the Swiss Performance Index (SPI) aims to achieve long-term asset growth.

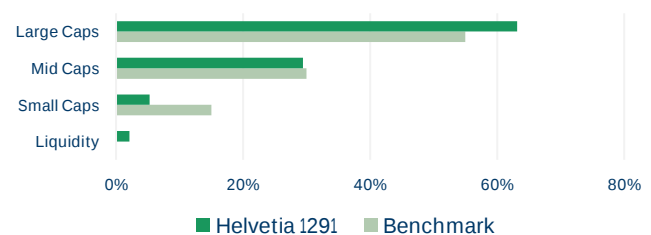
